1/FALSE: Maewyn Succat, also known as Saint Patrick, was born in Scotland in 393.

2/FALSE: The first Saint Patrick's Day parade took place in Boston (USA) in 1737.

3/FALSE: The original colour associated with the Patron Saint of Ireland is blue. Green appeared in 1798 when the shamrock became a national symbol.

4/FALSE and TRUE: Ireland hasn't got an official national day. Informally, Irish people celebrate their pride on Saint Patrick's Day, which is a Christian holiday.
