THE NOSE

- * Use beige cotton yarn and a 2 mm crochet hook size
- * The nose is crocheted with rows and no rounds...so ch 1 and turn before to start the new rows.
- * Crochet hdc at the R1 only.

R1. Ch3, 1 hdc in the first ch , Ch1, turn	2 hdc
R2. [inc] x2, ch1, turn	4 sts
R3. [inc], 2 sc,[inc], ch 1, turn	6 sts
R4. 1sc in each st around	6 sts
R5. [inc], 4 sc, [inc], ch 1, turn	8 sts
R6. sc in each st around	8 sts

At the end of row 6, don't turn and crochet around the piece (triangle) with 1 sc in each sts and 2 sc in each 3 corners. Join the first st with a sl st. Leave a 8 " thread to sew the nose.

Rnd1. 6sc in a magic ring 6 sts
 Rnd 2. [inc] x 6 12 sts
 Rnd 3-7. sc in each st around 12 sts

JOIN THE LEGS TOGETHER AND START THE BODY

*When your legs are finished, place them side by side : Crochet together with 1sc the right and left leg together (this is the beginning of a new rnd = rnd 8). Crochet 24 sc around the 2 feet.

*Don't forget to stuff firmly the legs and the body.

Rnd 35-43	1 sc in each st around	48 sts
Rnd 44.	[6sc, inc] x6	42 sts
Rnd 45.	[5sc, inc] x6	36 sts
Rnd 46.	[4sc, inc] x6	30 sts
Rnd 47.	[3sc, inc] x6	24 sts
Rnd 48.	[2sc, inc] x6	18 sts
Rnd 49.	[1sc, inc] x6	12 sts
Rnd 50.	[1 inc] x6	6 sts

* Continue with 1 or 2 dec to close the hole.

*FO and sew the lasts sts tog; weave in loose ends.



Sew the parts together...

*Sew the nose with the remaining thread. With a single strand of thread, you can embroider some sewings .

*The top of the nose in on the rnd 34.

*Place the eyes on the rnd 34 too.

*Sew the ears on the rnd 45.

*Sew the arms on the rnd 27.



Your sweet bunny is finally done. Use plastic safety eyes or sew them to secure your work if the bunny is for a children.
