## Les Pierres d'Aurèle

## **Presentation and Philosphy:**

"The vineyard of 20 ha extends over two large soils typical of the region of Chenonceaux.

- 13 ha surround the estate, on a stony soil of Clay to Flint
- 7 ha are located 3 km from the estate, on a ridge of sedimentary sand deposited by the Cher to the Tertiary Era ..
- These soils gave their names to the four "cottages" that line the vineyards closest to the building.

And to guarantee the sustainability of our practices, the vines are grown according to the Terra Vitis® production charter. The vines are grassed all year long and each of our interventions comes from a careful observation of the vineyard. We do not use insecticide and anti-rot and we regularly analyze our grapes to guarantee the total absence of treatment residues in our wines."

## The wines of the winery (Selection) :

• **Phillo :** 'Ripe and refined notes of citrus, peach, pineapple and passion fruit. Its fleshy mouth will give way to a fresh, aromatic and gourmet finish ..... "

• **Pyros :** "The palate is concentrated, full and fleshy. There are subtle notes of blackberries, blueberries and violets with an intense spicy finish. "

• **Chrysos :** "Its bubbles, fine and delicate, exhale aromas of citrus and white flowers. Its mouth, more mineral, will leave an aromatic finish with hints of peaches and white-fleshed fruits. "


